



RESOLUTION NO. 02-2006

TO APPROVE THE REQUEST OF THE PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTER (PICC) TO EXTEND THE PRESENT CONTRACT FOR SECURITY SERVICES BEYOND THE AGGREGATE PERIOD OF TWO (2) MONTHS CONTRACT EXTENSION

WHEREAS, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB), created under Section 63 of Republic Act No. 9184 (R.A. 9184), issued through GPPB Resolution No. 08-2005, the Guidelines for the Extension of Contracts for General Services on 28 April 2005, which took effect on 05 July 2005 in its 4th Regular Board Meeting of 2005;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned guidelines govern the extension of on-going contracts of general services which are essential, indispensable, or necessary to support the operation of the Procuring Entity or for the enhancement of the welfare of its personnel to include, but shall not be limited to, services such as equipment maintenance, janitorial and security services, and internet and telephone services;

WHEREAS, Section 5.1 of the above-mentioned guidelines provides that unless otherwise approved by the GPPB and upon written request of the Procuring Entity, contract extension shall be allowed only on a periodic month-to-month basis not to exceed an aggregate period of two (2) months;

WHEREAS, the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC) requests through a letter, dated 30 November 2005, approval and/or authority from the GPPB to extend the present contract for security services with CHEVRON Security Agency, beyond the allowable aggregate period of two (2) months contract extension;

WHEREAS, PICC's contract with their present contractor for security services expired on 24 November 2004;

WHEREAS, the first bidding conducted by PICC – Bids and Awards Committee (PICC-BAC) for the Award of the One Year Contract was declared as a failed bid since no bidder was determined to be the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB);

WHEREAS, PICC has already extended the contract with their present contractor for security services on a month-to-month basis for an aggregate period of two (2) months and the last day of the second (2nd) extension will be on 24 January 2006;

WHEREAS, having met all the terms and conditions provided under the above-mentioned guidelines, the Inter-Agency Technical Working Group (IATWG) in its meeting on 18 January 2006, recommends that the GPPB grant PICC's request for

extension of the services of the incumbent security agency, from month to month until the completion of the procurement process, but not to exceed an aggregate period of two (2) months.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **WE**, the Members of the **GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT POLICY BOARD**, by virtue of the powers vested on **US** by law, hereby **RESOLVE** to confirm and approve, as **WE** hereby approve the PICC's request for extension of contract for security services with their incumbent security agency, **CHEVRON Security Agency**, from month to month until the completion of the procurement process; but such extension shall not exceed an aggregate period of two (2) months.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
