

# **GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT POLICY BOARD**

## **RESOLUTION NO. 019-2004**

**AUTHORIZING THE SELECTED STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES THROUGH THEIR DULY TRAINED REPRESENTATIVES TO CONDUCT THE OFFICIAL PROCUREMENT TRAINING ON THE PHILIPPINE BIDDING DOCUMENTS (PBDs) FOR NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES (NGAs), GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS (GFIs), GOVERNMENT OWNED AND CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS (GOCCs), OTHER STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCs) IN THEIR RESPECTIVE REGIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as “Government Procurement Reform Act”, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A (IRR-A) took effect on January 26, 2003 and October 8, 2003 respectively;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 63.1 (d) of IRR-A of R.A. 9184, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) is mandated to ensure the proper implementation by procuring entities of R.A. 9184 and its IRR-A and all other relevant rules and regulations pertaining to public procurement;

**WHEREAS**, Section 63.1 (e) of IRR-A of R.A. 9184 mandates the GPPB to establish a sustainable training program to develop the capacity of Government procurement officers and employees, and to ensure the conduct of regular procurement training programs by and for procuring entities;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the afore-cited mandates, the GPPB Technical Support Office (GPPB-TSO), in cooperation with the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP), initiated development of the Public Procurement Practitioners’ Development Program with an initial trainors’ seminar in the use of PBDs participated in by representatives from selected state universities and colleges nationwide on October 18-22, 2004;

**WHEREAS**, the participating SUCs through their designated trainors shall be tasked to handle the training of procurement officials and practitioners of the NGAs, GFIs, GOCCs, and other SUCs located within their respective regions;

**WHEREAS**, after completion of the required training course, the duly authorized SUCs, through their trainors, are expected to conduct trainings on the use of the PBDs for Goods, Consulting Services and Civil Works in favor of NGAs, GFIs, GOCCs, and other SUCs within their respective regions;

**WHEREAS**, to sustain the conduct of procurement trainings for the NGAs, GFIs, GOCCs and other SUCs in the different regions and at the same time augment their resources, the SUCs may charge basic fees for the conduct of the training contained in the Regional Strategic Plan submitted to the GPPB-TSO;

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**WHEREAS**, NGAs, GFIs, GOCCs, and other SUCs through their agency heads should be advised of the conduct of such procurement training in their respective regions in order for them to accordingly direct/order their procurement personnel and officials to attend the same;

**WHEREAS**, during the 8<sup>th</sup> meeting of the GPPB held on December 22, 2004, at Unit 2506 Raffles Corporate Center, Emerald Avenue, Ortigas Center, Pasig City, the official list of duly authorized SUCs and their respective trainers was submitted for the consideration of the members of the Board per record of the GPPB-TSO. Attached herein is the official list of duly authorized SUCs and their respective trainers, per record of the GPPB-TSO.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of all the foregoing, We, the Members of the **GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT POLICY BOARD**, by virtue of the powers vested on **US** by law, hereby **RESOLVE** to authorize the selected SUCs through their duly trained representatives, hereby designated as SUC trainers, to conduct official procurement trainings on the Philippine Bidding Documents for Goods, Consulting Services, and Civil Works to NGAs, GFIs, GOCCs, and other SUCs within their respective regions.

**IN VIEW OF THE ABOVE PREMISES**, all heads of the different branches, agencies, departments, bureaus, offices and instrumentalities of the Government, including government-owned and/or controlled corporations, government financial institutions, state universities and colleges are hereby directed to send their respective procurement officials/personnel to attend the official trainings on Philippine Bidding Documents to be conducted by the authorized SUCs through their duly trained representatives within the region in preparation for its mandatory use effective March 2005 .

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
