SUBJECT: Submission of Tax Returns and "Tax Clearance for purposes of E.O. 398" as Eligibility Requirements for the Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services, in compliance with Executive Order No. 398, Revenue Regulation No. 03-2005, and Revenue Memorandum Circular No. 16-2005

1.0 **Purpose**

This circular is issued to enforce compliance with the provisions of Executive Order No. 398 (E.O. 398), attached hereto as Annex "A", and Revenue Regulation No. 03-2005 (RR 03-2005), attached as hereto Annex "B", including Revenue Memorandum Circular No. 16-2005 (RMC 16-2005), attached hereto as Annex "C", requiring the submission of tax returns and tax clearance as a pre-condition in entering or participating in any contract with the government.

2.0 Coverage

All Departments, Bureaus, Offices and Agencies of the National Government; Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), including State Universities and Colleges (SUCs); and Local Government Units (LGUs).

3.0 **Rules and Regulations**

3.1 In addition to Class "A" Legal Documents required under the Eligibility Requirements for the Procurement of Goods and Infrastructure Projects. and Consulting Services, under Sections 23.6 and 24.7 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A (IRR-A) of Republic Act No. 9184 (R.A. 9184) respectively, procuring entities are mandated to require prospective bidders the submission of tax returns and the Tax Clearance (for purposes of E.O. 398) in compliance with the provisions of E.O. 398, RR 03-2005, and RMC 16-2005.
