## **CIRCULAR NO. 04-2005**

**TO: Heads of Departments, Bureaus, Offices and Agencies of the National Government; Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), including State Universities and Colleges (SUCs); and Local Government Units (LGUs)**

**SUBJECT: Mandatory Use of the Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs) for the Procurement of Goods, Civil Works, and Consulting Services Edition II as Harmonized with the ADB, JBIC and World Bank Procurement Rules**

### **1.0 Purpose**

This circular is issued to advise government agencies on the mandatory use of the PBDs Edition II as Harmonized with the Asian Development Bank (ADB), Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC), and World Bank Procurement Rules.

### **2.0 Coverage**

All Departments, Bureaus, Offices and Agencies of the National Government; Government-Owned or Controlled Corporations (GOCCs), including State Universities and Colleges (SUCs); and Local Government Units (LGUs).

### **3.0 Rules And Regulations**

In accordance with the GPPB Resolution No. 010-2005, Adopting the PBDs Edition II as Harmonized with the ADB, JBIC and World Bank Procurement Rules issued on May 26, 2005 in its 5<sup>th</sup> GPPB meeting, all branches, agencies, departments, bureaus, offices and instrumentalities of the Government, including GOCCs, GFIs, SUCs, and LGUs, are hereby mandated to use the PBDs Edition II in the preparation of their bidding documents for all of their procurement activities effective July 1, 2005.
