

## APPROVING THE NEW ANNUAL PROCUREMENT PLAN (APP) FORMAT

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) took effect on 26 January 2003 and 2 September 2009, respectively;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of RA No. 9184 and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) mandates the preparation of the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) which should include procurements considered crucial to the efficient discharge of governmental functions;

WHEREAS, Executive Order (EO) No. 662<sup>1</sup> series of 2007, as amended, prescribes the contents of the APP, to wit: (i) name of project/procurement; (ii) project management office or end-user unit; (iii) general description of the project/procurement; (iv) procurement methods to be adopted; (v) time schedule for each procurement activity; (vi) source of funds; and (vii) budgetary estimate.

WHEREAS, the current prescribed APP format, as uploaded in the GPPB website, was approved by the GPPB on 29 February 2008;

**WHEREAS**, recognizing the importance of the APP, the Office of the President issued Administrative Order No. 46, Series of  $2015^2$  which included the submission of the APP to the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) within the first month of the year (or for those, who have not submitted, to comply before the end of April), as one of the measures to speed up the procurement process;

WHEREAS, another documentary requirement is the submission of APP for Common-Use Supplies and Equipment (APP-CSE) to the Department of Budget and Management – Procurement Service (DBM-PS) pursuant to DBM Circular Letter No 2013-14 dated 29 November 2013;

WHEREAS, the submission of the APP-CSE to the DBM-PS is for the purpose of determining the quarterly cash requirements for common-use supplies, materials, and equipment of the agency and for the over-all management of the centralized procurement of common-use goods by the DBM-PS.

WHEREAS, the APP-CSE does not contain the information prescribed by EO No. 662;

WHEREAS, during the 4<sup>th</sup> Regular GPPB Meeting the GPPB-TSO recommended to the Board the issuance of a Circular reiterating the preparation and submission of the APP
