Re: Sworn Affidavit of No Pending or Previous Adversarial Claim

Dear Mr. Pagalilauan:

We refer to your letter seeking clarification principally on whether it is valid for a procuring entity, specifically the Home Development Mutual Fund (PAG-IBIG), to require as a post-qualification requirement, under Section 29.2 (d) of the Bid Data Sheet (BDS), a Sworn Affidavit stating that the bidder shall have no pending or previous adversarial claim against PAG-IBIG; and to consequently post-disqualify a bidder who has filed such a case against members of PAG-IBIG's Bids and Awards Committee (BAC).

It is represented that Region Security and Investigation Agency (RSI Agency) was post-disqualified for having failed in one of the additional documentary requirements of the BAC provided in Section 34.2 (d) of the revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, and in Clause 29.2 (d) of its Bid Data Sheet (BDS), *Other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the BDS*. This is for the reason that Pag-IBIG Fund Tuguegarao Office required a Sworn Affidavit stating that the bidder shall have no pending or previous adversarial claim against PAG-IBIG before any judicial or quasi-judicial body or any other tribunal or agency. However, RSI Agency was found to have instituted two (2) separate cases against PAG-IBIG before the Office of the Deputy Ombudsman for Luzon, specifically against the BAC members of PAG-IBIG Regional Office No. 2.

At the outset, we wish to inform you that the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) and its Technical Support Office (GPPB-TSO) only render policy and non-policy opinions, respectively, on issues purely relating to the interpretation and application of our procurement laws, rules, and regulations. It has no jurisdiction to rule over actual controversies with regard to the conduct of the bidding since it has no quasi-judicial functions or investigatory powers under the law. Moreover, we adhere to the position that apart from courts having actual jurisdiction over the subject matter of a case, we cannot, nor any other government agency, authority, or official, encroach upon or interfere with the exercise of the functions of the BAC, since these duties and responsibilities fall solely within the ambit of its authority and discretion as sanctioned by law.

### **Post-Qualification Process**

The objective of post-qualification under Section 34 of RA 9184 and its revised IRR is to determine whether the bidder complies with and is responsive to all the legal, technical and financial requirements and conditions specified in the bidding documents. During post-qualification, the procuring entity verifies, validates and ascertains all statements made and the documents submitted by the bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) or Highest Rated Bid using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as stated in the bidding documents.<sup>2</sup>

The post-qualification shall consider the legal, technical and financial requirements, such as, but not limited to, the bidder's stated competence and experience, the availability and commitment, and/or inspection and testing of the equipment units to be owned or leased by the bidder, the performance of the bidder in its ongoing government and private contracts, the goods/product, after-sales and/or maintenance capabilities for the procurement of goods. Hence, the verification entailed under the post-qualification stage is not limited to the examination of documents submitted by the bidder, but includes verification and inspection of the subject equipment *vis-à-vis* the technical specifications specified in the bidding documents.

In addition, Section 34.2<sup>5</sup> of the revised IRR provides that within three (3) calendar days from receipt by the bidder of the notice from the BAC that it has the LCB, the bidder shall submit the following documentary requirements: (a) Latest income and business tax returns; (b) Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration; and (c) Other appropriate licenses and permits required by law and stated in the Bidding Documents. Failure to submit said documentary requirements on time or a finding against the veracity of such shall be a ground for the disqualification of the bidder and forfeiture of its bid security.

#### Additional Requirements in Post-Qualification

In line with the foregoing, we express the view that the provision requiring for a Sworn Affidavit from the bidder in the Bid Data Sheet is not the same as the submission of additional licenses or permits for purposes of post-qualification as sanctioned under Section 34.2 of the revised IRR. An Affidavit executed by a bidder disclosing that it has not filed any case against the procuring entity is neither a license nor permit required by law that can be requested for submission during the post-qualification stage. If the procuring entity shall impose such additional requirement of a Sworn Affidavit under Section 34.2 of the IRR, it is in effect amending the provisions of the revised IRR, an act beyond its jurisdictional authority and power to perform.<sup>6</sup>

In this regard, we opine that the required sworn affidavit attesting to the fact that the bidder has no pending or previous adversarial claim against PAG-IBIG is not a license or permit identified by law that can be required additionally during the post-qualification stage. The contested provision runs counter to RA 9184 and its revised IRR inasmuch as it imposes an additional post-qualification requirement.



#### Dear Sir/Madam:

Our agencies, Region Manpower Services and Region Security and Investigation Agency, would like to request for your legal/policy opinion, on the BAC interpretation that our agencies may be post-disqualified under their post-qualification requirements under ITB Clause 29.2 (d) in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS). (Hereto attached as Annex "A").

In view of the foregoing, the following are our issues:

- 1. Whether or not a prospective bidder maybe post-disqualified if the bidder filed a case before the Ombudsman against the members of the BAC of HDMF-Regional Office No. 2 in the previous bidding, citing the post-qualification requirement in the 29.2. (d) "Sworn Affidavit stating the following provision: That the bidder shall have no pending or previous adversarial claim against the PAG-IBIG Fund before any judicial or quasi-judicial body or any other tribunal or agency".
- Whether or not the post-qualification requirement above-stated is invalid, because it doesn't comply with the requirements set forth under ITB Clause 29.2. (d) Other appropriate licenses and permits required by law AND stated in the BDS, since it is not a license and a permit required by law.
- 3. Whether or not filing a case before the Ombudsman against the members of the BAC of HDMF-Regional Office No. 2, constitute an adversarial claim against the PAG-IBIG Fund.
