Re: Factor "K" in the NFCC Computation

Dear Ms. Del Castillo:

This refers to your letter dated 29 September 2014 requesting clarification on whether the factor "K" in the NFCC Computation refers to the duration of the contract similar in nature to the contract to be bid or the duration of on-going contracts.

We wish to inform you that we have clarified this matter in NPM No. 96-2012¹ using as reference the interpretation of the same provision of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Executive Order 40², where the existing provision in Section 23(a)(vi) of the revised IRR of Republic Act No. 9184 regarding NFCC was lifted. Hence, the value of "K" shall be based on the duration of the contract under consideration, or the would be contract subject of the bidding opportunity.

We hope this opinion issued by the GPPB-TSO provided sufficient guidance on the matter. Note that this is issued on the basis of particular facts and situations presented, and may not be applicable given a different set of facts and circumstances.
