## Re: Statement of Ongoing and Completed Government and Private Contracts

Dear Ms. Rosete:

This refers to your electronic mail dated 11 December 2015, which we received on 14 December 2015, inquiring on whether there has been any revision on the statement of the prospective bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts in relation to your procurement of security services.

By virtue of Section 63 of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) was established to formulate and amend, whenever necessary, the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). Since the effectivity of RA 9814 and its associated IRR, the GPPB has adopted several procurement policies, which includes the amendment of Section 23.1(a)(iii)<sup>1</sup> of the IRR of RA 9184 through GPPB Resolution No.  $29-2012^2$  issued on 23 November 2012.

Subsequently, the GPPB, through GPPB Resolution No. 16-2014 dated 20 June  $2014^3$ , resolved to amend Section 23.1(a)(iv) of the IRR and Clauses 12.1 of the Instructions to Bidders (ITB) and 12.1(a)(iii) of the Bid Data Sheet (BDS) of the Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs) for Goods and Infrastructure Projects, thus:

As can be gleaned from the foregoing, the statement of all ongoing government and private contracts was distinguished from the "statement identifying the single largest completed contract" and "the ten (10) year period for the completed similar contract"; and the phrase "within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents" were deleted, and the associated provisions in the PBDs were amended to reflect the changes pursuant to GPPB Resolution 16-2014.

In sum, the following are the latest amendments effected anent the statement of all ongoing government and private contracts concerning the procurement of security services:

- 1. Distinction between the statement of all ongoing government and private contracts from the statement identifying the single largest completed contract; and
- 2. Deletion of the ten (10) year period for the completed similar contract and the phrase "within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents"

We hope that this opinion issued by the GPPB-TSO provided sufficient guidance on the matter. Note that this opinion is being issued on the basis of facts and particular situations presented, and may not be applicable given a different set of facts and circumstances.
