Brief Background on RA 12009

RA 12009 or the **New Government Procurement Act (NGPA)** is a landmark legislation that modernizes and streamlines public procurement in the Philippines to promote efficiency, transparency, accountability, and inclusivity.

Why the change?

Identified Gaps in RA 9184

slow processes, low bidder participation, and challenges in contract implementation

Need for Modernization

digital transformation, sustainable procurement approaches, and risk-based procurement planning

Ensures that all procurement are undertaken with proper and sufficient planning and preparation

-  Early Procurement Activities
-  Life Cycle Assessment and Life Cycle Costing Analysis
-  Engagement of a Procurement Agent
-  Renewal of Regular & Recurring Services
-  Use of Framework Agreement
-  Design and Build Scheme
-  Pooled Procurement

Enhances Transparency and Ensures Greater Accountability

Ensures procurement processes are more open and accessible to the public by:


-  Providing access to information consistent with open contracting practices and standards
-  Strengthening oversight mechanisms to promote accountability
