



**APPROVAL OF THE INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL TRAINERS IN THE ROSTER OF THE GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT POLICY BOARD-RECOGNIZED TRAINERS**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act (RA) No. 12009, otherwise known as the “New Government Procurement Act,” took effect on 13 August 2024, while its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) took effect on 25 February 2025;

**WHEREAS**, Section 91 of RA No. 12009 mandates that the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) shall be the central body that sets strategic direction and makes policy decisions regarding all matters affecting public procurement, having due regard to the country’s regional and international obligations, and is tasked to lead the nation’s efforts in advancing public procurement reforms in accordance with the Act;

**WHEREAS**, Section 109 of RA No. 12009 mandates for a whole-of-government approach and directs the GPPB to provide sustained training, capacity-building, and support to stakeholders in the government procurement process, such as education, seminars, and workshops in areas such as modes of procurement, streamlined processes, supply chain management and logistics including warehousing and digitalization;

**WHEREAS**, the GPPB issued Circular 07-2018<sup>1</sup> providing, among others, the Guidelines and Conditions in the Recognition of GPPB of the Existing Pool of Procurement Trainers;

**WHEREAS**, Section 5.2 of the GPPB Circular 01-2025<sup>2</sup> provides that the Procuring Entities shall continue to use the guidelines and forms issued under RA No. 9184 and its IRR until the necessary guidelines, forms and requirements under the relevant provisions of RA No. 12009 and its IRR have been issued by the GPPB;

**WHEREAS**, the GPPB currently has one hundred and ninety-two (192) Recognized Trainers in its pool, comprised of long-practicing procurement trainers and those confirmed through GPPB Resolution Nos. 01-2020,<sup>3</sup> 19-2021,<sup>4</sup> 03-2024,<sup>5</sup> and 10-2024,<sup>6</sup> of which one hundred and forty-nine (149) are active and forty-three (43) are inactive;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the increased need for procurement training following the implementation of RA No. 12009, the GPPB-Technical Support Office (TSO) conducted a new round of the Recruitment, Selection, and Recognition Program from 04 August 2025 to 24 November 2025;

**WHEREAS**, on 04 December 2025, the GPPB – TSO presented to the Inter-Agency Technical Working Group (IATWG) the proposed inclusion of seventy-seven (77) qualified candidates from various parts of the country who successfully completed the Recruitment, Selection, and Recognition Program to the Roster of GPPB-Recognized Trainers;

**WHEREAS**, after further review of the subject proposal and upon recommendation by the GPPB-TSO and the GPPB IATWG, the same was submitted to the GPPB for approval ad referendum;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **WE**, the Members of the **GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT POLICY BOARD**, by virtue of the powers vested on **US** by law and other executive issuances, hereby **RESOLVE** to confirm, adopt, and approve, as **WE** hereby confirm, adopt, and approve ad referendum the following:

1. **APPROVE** the inclusion of seventy seven (77) additional trainers in the Roster of GPPB - Recognized Trainers who successfully completed the Recruitment, Selection, and Recognition Program, and whose names are listed on the document attached herein as **Annex "A,"** subject to their completion of the Onboarding Program and the execution of Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) or Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the GPPB-TSO; and
2. **DIRECT** the GPPB-TSO to continuously maintain an updated List of GPPB - Recognized Trainers, as well as existing trainers who have completed the regular retooling program and maintained their compliance with requirements in the signed MOA or MOU. In addition, the GPPB-TSO shall submit to the GPPB the updated List of GPPB – Recognized Trainers.
